Terms of Use

Thank you for accessing this website www.lsbud.co.uk (the “**website**”). Please read these Terms of Use before using this website which is operated by LinesearchbeforeUdig Limited, a company registered in England and Wales whose registered office and main trading address is at The Head Office Ivanhoe Office Park, Ivanhoe Park Way, Ashby-De-La-Zouch, Leicestershire, England, LE65 2AB (registered with number 7822531 and VAT number GB 128615804) (“**We**” “**Us**” “**Our**”). We operate this website for the purpose of promoting and providing the services supplied by Us under the website including the LinesearchbeforeUdig service (the “**service**”). By using this website, you signify your acceptance of these Terms of Use in return for which We will provide you with access. - Electricity Distribution Network Operators, Electricity Transmission Operators, Gas Distribution Operators, and Gas Transmission Operators as defined by Energy Networks Association excluding Independent Distribution Network Operators. - Telephone records. We will keep these up to 6 months from the time the recording was made.

Who Might We Share Your Information With?

You agree that for the purposes set out in the *'Why do We collect this information?'* section above, We have the right to share your personal information with selected associated third parties, some of whom We appoint to provide services, including:

- Business partners, suppliers and subcontractors necessary to facilitate the provision of any services linked to the LSBUD service such as the Top-Up Service.
- Other companies within Our group, business partners, cloud hosted servers, suppliers and subcontractors necessary for the performance of any contract We enter into with you.
